

General Information

Momentum Inc. with registered office in Blvd. Ilinden 43/5, 1000 Skopje, Republic of Macedonia, as the owner of the personal data voluntarily communicated by (verbally, via e-mail, through the website, etc.), provides you with the following information concerning the processing of personal data pursuant to Article 13, GDPR (in short, "Information").

Personal data according to the European legislation definition (GDPR – Regulation 2016/679) means: any information to identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identification number or to one or more factors specific to his physical, physiological, mental, economic, cultural or social identity;

What personal information do we collect from the people that visit our blog, website or app?

When registering for participation in one of the workshops, presentations or other activities, or when applying to participate as an exhibitor, performer or in another form of participation at the events organized by Momentum Inc., you may be asked to enter your name, email address, phone number or other details to help you with your experience.

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you register for or apply for participation in any one of our events, when you subscribe to a newsletter, fill out a form or enter information on our site.

How do we use your information?

With your consent (Article 7, GDPR), we may use the information we collect from when you register, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use certain other site features in the following ways:

- To personalize your experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content and product offerings in which you are most interested.
- To allow us to better service you in responding to your customer service requests.
- To send periodic emails regarding our products and services.
- To follow up after correspondence (email or phone inquiries).

How do we protect your information?

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential.

As regards the use of these data for marketing purposes, the legal basis we use is legitimate interest for marketing communications with users of our Home Solutions (based on Recital 47 of GDPR that is implementing the EU E-privacy directive), unless those persons have opted out. We may use these data for marketing purposes for maximum period of contractual duration, plus three years after the contract is terminated, except if the data subject has opted out from these communications at any moment in time. After this time expires the data will be deleted or anonymized.

What are Cookies

Exercisable rights

In compliance with the provisions of articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR, you can exercise the rights indicated therein and in particular:

Right of access - To obtain confirmation that personal data processing concerning you is being processed and, in this case, to receive information relating, in particular, to: purpose of processing, categories of personal data processed and retention period, recipients where these can be communicated (Article 15, GDPR),

Right of rectification - To obtain, without undue delay, the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you and the integration of incomplete personal data (Article 16, GDPR),

Right to cancel - To obtain, without undue delay, the cancellation of personal data concerning you, in the cases provided for by the GDPR (Article 17, GDPR),

Right of limitation - To obtain from the co-controllers the limitation of the treatment, in the cases foreseen by the GDPR (article 18, GDPR),

Right to portability - Receive in a structured format, in common use and readable by an automatic device, the personal data that you provide to the co-controllers, as well as obtain that the same are transmitted to another holder without impediments, in the cases provided by the GDPR (article 20, GDPR),

Right to object - Oppose to the processing of personal data concerning you, unless there are legitimate reasons for the co-owners to continue processing (Article 21, GDPR),

Right to propose a complaint to the supervisory authority - Propose a complaint to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data. You may exercise these rights by simply sending a request to the Data Protection Officer, as indicated above.

Method of treatment

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of the operations indicated in article 4, no. 2), GDPR - performed with or without the aid of computer systems - namely: collection, registration, organization, structuring, updating, preservation, adaptation or modification, extraction and analysis, consultation, use, communication by transmission, comparison, interconnection, limitation, cancellation or destruction.

In any case, the logical and physical security of the data and, in general, the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the personal data processed will be guaranteed, putting in place all the necessary technical and organizational measures.
